Light (if needed)

If you bring other items you will be asked to remove them from your work area during the contest. Ginny will be setting up a workstation with a variety of other tools contestants can share. The purpose of limiting your resources is to keep the playing field level.

After the judging, we will award 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, and there will be COOL PRIZES!
