Program:

This month Ginny Ford will demonstrate using translucent liquid polymer clay to create a faux ceramic tile effect on clay. We will be making a tile that can be used as a pin or a pendant.

Supplies:

Translucent liquid polymer clay
Pigment powders to tint the liquid clay
Polymer clay in a metallic color or a light color
(Color hint — using a lighter shade of the same color as your pigment powder works nicely)
Texture sheets/tools or a very shallow mold to impress a pattern on your tile
Standard basic tools — pasta machine, work surface, clay blade, needle tool, etc.
